

# Dining on the Disney Wish

Disney Cruise Line dining works very differently than dining inside the parks (or dining on other cruise lines). So, I want to take a moment to help you understand all of the ins and outs of navigating dining on your Disney Wish cruise.

At sea, there are three main dining rooms which are all part of Disney's unique Rotational Dining system. There's also casual dining on board, along with adult-exclusive dining opportunities.

## **HOW WILL YOU KNOW WHICH SEATING TIME YOU HAVE?**

There are two dinner seatings each night of your cruise on the Wish. **Times may vary based on the itinerary, but usually, dinner is served at either 5:45 p.m. (Main Seating) or 8:15 p.m. (Second Seating).**

You were assigned a seating time when we booked your cruise and it's reflected in your confirmation email. If you would like to change your seating time, we can make a request now. If it's not available, I'll add you to the waitlist, which is not guaranteed and is based on availability opening up.

**You will have your dining information shared with you via the Navigator App with an assigned seating time, restaurant schedule (for Rotational Dining), and individual table number.**

## **WHAT IS ROTATIONAL DINING?**

Rotational Dining simply means that for dinner you will rotate between the three main dining rooms during each night of your cruise. And, because great service is so important, your servers move with you.

You will get to experience each of the amazing Main Dining options listed below at least once!

- **Arendelle: A Frozen Dining Adventure**
  - Arendelle is inspired by Frozen and includes dinner and a show, complete with an animatronic Olaf, which is sure to delight the kids. This restaurant features elegant Nordic dishes.
- **Worlds Of Marvel Restaurant Avengers: Quantum Encounter Dining Experience**
  - Worlds of Marvel is a technologically sophisticated Marvel-themed dining adventure. This dining experience will transport you to an interactive world where a mission unfolds around you. You can expect cuisines from around the world, inspired by your favorite heroes.
- **1923**
  - Named for the year the Walt Disney Company was founded, this classic Hollywood restaurant is full of glamour. You are immersed in the early animation process via sketches and illustrations and surrounded by nostalgia from the Disney archives. 1923 features an elegant Hollywood-style menu inspired by a California fusion of cultural flavors.

## **WHAT ABOUT CASUAL DINING OPTIONS?**

Not into the rotational dining plan? Or maybe you just like to take one night to enjoy some casual dining instead. Whatever the case, you have plenty of options aboard the Wish!

- **Marceline Market**

Marceline Market is the main casual buffet aboard the Wish and is inspired by Walt Disney's hometown. It consists of 10 different food stalls giving you a choice of American classics, international specialties, comfort foods, seafood, soups and salads, vegetarian and plant-based eats, baked goods, and desserts, all served buffet-style.

- **Mickey and Friends Festival of Foods**

This fantastic food court is the perfect place to grab a quick lunch, dinner, or even a snack. Featuring mostly American cuisine, you'll have your choice from these appetizing eateries:

- Donald's Cantina
- Daisy's Pizza Pies
- Goofy's Grill
- Sweet Minnie's Ice Cream
