

Disney Park Policies

- ✓ Any strollers brought into the parks are required to be 31" wide and 52" long or smaller. The good news is that most strollers (even a lot of double strollers) fit into this criteria.
- ✓ Wagons, including Stroller Wagons, are prohibited in the parks.
- ✓ Loose ice or dry ice is not permitted in coolers brought into the parks. Disney recommends using reusable ice packs instead to keep your food and drinks cool. This is a security check-point issue. You can bring in zip lock bags of ice or request cups of ice at food & beverage locations inside the parks.
- ✓ Selfie sticks, hand-held extension poles for cameras or mobile devices, flags, and banners are not allowed in any theme park or water park.
- ✓ Balloons and Plastic Straws are not permitted at Disney's Animal Kingdom theme park, water parks, Disney's Animal Kingdom Lodge (Kidani and Jambo House) and other locations on property.
- ✓ Costumes may not be worn by any Guests ages 14 or older. And masks worn by younger Guests may not cover the entire face and must provide unobstructed peripheral vision.
- ✓ Children should be supervised. Guests under the age of 7 must be accompanied by a Guest age of 14 or older to enter a theme park or water park. To board an attraction, children under the age of 7 must be accompanied by a person age 14 years or older.
- ✓ Smoking areas are no longer present inside theme parks or water parks.

Designated smoking areas will still be located outside the entrances to the parks, in Disney Springs, and at your Disney resort.
