

Recreation on the Disney Magic

While the kids' clubs are an amazing feature, sometimes you just want a chance to have some active family fun and Disney Magic does not disappoint!

POOLS

Guests of all ages can enjoy swimming pools, along with other water areas.

- **Goofy's Pool:**
 - The largest kid-friendly pool, complete with 2 hot tubs, and located right next to Funnel Vision, the giant screen that plays Disney movies while you swim.
- **Huey, Dewey, and Louie Pool:**
 - This is the smaller of the kid-friendly pools. With Donald Duck's lovable, but mischievous nephew trio in the center of this shallow pool, little ones (age 3+) or new swimmers are sure to enjoy some well-deserved splash time, too, and usually away from the bigger kids, due to the shallower water!
- **Quiet Cove Pool:**
 - This adults-only pool is located towards the front of the ship to provide a more serene and peaceful environment than that of the family pools. It includes 2 hot tub areas and a bar. It's the perfect place to relax while the kids participate in other onboard activities.

Keep in mind adult supervision is required for anyone under 16 and lounge chairs are only available on a first-come, first-served basis.

There are also games and activities hosted by Cast Members throughout the day.

SPLASH ZONES

- **Nephews' Splash Zone:**
 - This is the only space where babies and toddlers are invited to participate in water play. It's located on the back of Deck 9 and features Huey, Dewey, and Louie spraying water as well as tiny ground sprinklers for a true splash pad effect.
 - **AquaLab:** An 1800 square foot pool and splash pad area for cruisers ages 3+, complete with a double looping waterslide that covers 250 feet of twists and turns! Also found in the AquaLab are rain showerheads, pop jets, and geysers to give everyone a chance to get wet and experiment with tons of fun gadgets and water play!

SPORTS AND FITNESS

Stay fit while on vacation at the full-service gym, featuring state-of-the-art weight machines and exercise equipment, and specialized fitness classes all while taking in magnificent ocean views.

Deck 10 on the Disney Magic is home to the **Wide World of Sports Deck** which features fitness and recreational sports activities for all ages. This giant, open-air space includes basketball courts, and ping-pong tables.

Other Activities

- **Shuffleboard**

- Try your hand at shuffleboard! Slide into fun on one of the shuffleboard courts, always waxed to perfection. Whether you play traditional one-on-one "knockoff," team up for "Horse Collar," or try the adventurous "Crazy Eight," shuffleboard on a cruise is essential.

- Lace up those running shoes and venture out for a 400-yard lap around the beautiful Deck! While running the ship's length and traveling on the port and starboard decks, you'll be treated to ocean views every step.
