

Specialty Dining on Disney Cruise Line

Disney's rotational dining allows you to eat at a different, beautifully themed restaurant each night, with some of the best food in the industry. But what's really special, is you have the same team of servers in each restaurant throughout your cruise!

In addition to rotational dining, Disney Cruise Line offers specialty dining to guests. The Disney Cruise Line specialty restaurants are open to adults only. However, there are a few family friendly events as well.

Adult Only Specialty Dining Options

Palo (available on *Disney Magic*, *Disney Wonder*, *Disney Dream*, and *Disney Fantasy*)

Named after the signature long poles used by gondoliers in Venice, Palo serves an adult-exclusive restaurant serving Italian fare in an intimate setting amid stunning seaside views.

Fine Italian cookery begins with artfully prepared antipasti, soft potato gnocchi piennolo in tomato sauce with kale, fritto di calamari e gamba marinara, or sip on a steaming stew of seafood favorites scented with basil and garlic. Continue with a plate of classic pasta such as penne arrabbiata.

For your main course, be transported to the heart of Italy as you pamper your palate with freshly prepared specialties that include butternut agnolotti, seared sea scallops on celery root puree – or entice your taste buds with a house favorite: piquant dover sole (fileted table side), garnished with brown nut butter garnished with chopped capers.

At Palo, incomparable Italian dining and impeccable service sure to exceed your expectations are always on the menu.

True to form, there's an abundance of fine European wines and Italian-American-inspired cocktails like the Bellini and the Italian surfer—and cappuccino, espresso, lattes, and café mochas.

For a sweet ending, discover a culinary confection of freshly made desserts, including homemade tiramisù, panna cotta, or our house favorite: chocolate soufflé with vanilla bean and chocolate sauce.

Palo Steakhouse (available on the *Disney Wish*)

Inspired by Cogsworth from *Beauty and the Beast*, this adult-exclusive restaurant strikes a balance between the time-honored Italian fare of the original Disney Palo restaurants and modern steakhouse dining.

This beautiful, Venetian-themed restaurant provides an elegant date-night atmosphere to help you relax and unwind after a day of kid-focused activities. Dinner is served between 6-9 pm at Palo, and there is a dress requirement.

An elegant, welcoming environment with mesmerizing ocean views off the back of the ship, this restaurant was designed with a luxurious palette of rich warm woods and shining metals, along with artwork and details that evoke ornate clocks, pendulums and gears, in true Cogsworth style.

The fare served is authentic, decadent Italian cuisine, so delectable it'll have you thinking you're in Italy! You'll love sipping a glass of wine and enjoying adult conversation, a rich dessert, and ambient live piano music. After all, it's *your* vacation, too!

Remy (*available on Disney Fantasy or Disney Dream*)

A French-inspired menu of superior seasonal ingredients ensures dining at Remy is always a first-rate gastronomic affair. Gourmet selections are specially crafted by Chef Scott Hunnel, from the award-winning Victoria & Albert's at Walt Disney World Resort, and advising Chef Arnaud Lallement—a 3-Michelin-starred chef.

At Remy, Chef Arnaud presents a dinner menu steeped in the rich legacy of epicurean excellence. Dinner begins with a complimentary “Collette,” a chilled Champagne cocktail prepared at your table. A quick glance at the seasonal menu reveals Chef Arnaud’s culinary influence throughout, with multiple tasting courses celebrating the sea, the earth, and fresh ingredients culled from the world market.
